The registration form is attached. You must register in order to participate in scheduled events, reserve a trade show table and to enjoy special hotel rates. The registration fee for members and guests includes the banquet on Monday, November 8.

Without advance registration, we may not be able to accommodate you. We accept checks in US dollars drawn on a US bank or International money orders. You can also use PayPal. Hotel Reservations

The Pine Needles Lodge and Mid-Pines Inn are located at 1005 and 1010 Midland Road, Southern Pines, NC. You may request a room at either Pine Needles or Mid Pines and the reservations staff will accommodate you, based on availability. If you plan to engage in room trading, we recommend that you request the Mid-Pines Inn. However, the Inn does not have elevators.

To make your hotel reservations please phone 1-800-747-7272 and identify yourself as a GCS member. Rates for the meeting dates are \$115/night per person for single occupancy and \$57.50/night per person double occupancy. All rates are subject to 7% NC State Sales tax and 3% Moore County Occupancy Tax. A credit card or payment for one night's room and tax is required to hold your reservation. ***Please make your reservations directly with the resort, rather than through their web site.***

We strongly encourage you to stay at the Pine Needles/Mid Pines Resort so we are able to fulfill our room night obligations.

The cut-off date for hotel reservations is Friday, **October 22, 2010**. There is no guarantee of rates or availability after 10/22.

Hotel Cancellation Policy: Reservations canceled prior to Friday, October 22, will result in a full refund of the deposit. Individual reservations canceled or changed within 29-14 days of arrival will be refunded deposit, less a \$50.00 handling fee. Reservations canceled within 13-3 days of arrival will result in forfeiture of entire deposit. galleries. A tour guide offers an overview of what pottery making entails, and interesting anecdotes and details about what's available at each pottery stop. Pottery will be available for sale directly from the potters, but there's no pressure to purchase. Guests will be able to experience "throwing a pot". Tour limited to first 35 to sign up.
