Welcome to the California Hickory “North-South”. This event is a **two-day hickory golf** tournament to be held on the 1932 Chandler Egan designed Pacific Grove Golf Links. Pacific Grove Golf Links is known as “the poor man’s Pebble Beach” and for good reason. The course is on the northwestern tip of the Monterey peninsula, about 5 miles from Pebble Beach. Pacific Ocean and Monterey Bay views are visible from almost every hole on the course, with the back 9 situated right along the coast in links style. A par 70 from just over 5,700 yards, this course is great for hickory play and very walkable. Oh, and while most of the country is roasting in the summer heat, the average day time high temperature at tournament time is a nice 66 degrees!

Format:

For the **first round** (Saturday June 30), all players will be split into two teams; North team, or South team. Each player will play their own ball from tee to green, holing out their own ball is a must, no matter the score. The better score of the two-man team will count against their opponents in Match Play format. After the round, either the North or South team will be crowned champions. The individual score will be added to second round score.

The **second round** (Sunday July 1) will be individual stroke play. The scores from round one will be added to the score from round two for a two-day total score. Prizes for Open and Net play. (1st tee times for both rounds start at 8:30 am)

We can all hang out after golf at course grill for drinks and meals at own cost. I am sure many will want to hang out at a hotel or somewhere and socialize. A nice idea may be to drive the few miles to Pebble Beach and have a drink on the patio of the Lodge's bar and grill overlooking still water cove and the 18th hole!

* The Monterey Peninsula is one of the most beautiful places in our country. It is a great place to arrive early or stay late for a small vacation. There are many attractions and sites to see for you, and or spouse before, during, or after golf. Pebble Beach golf links (and many other beautiful courses), 17 mile drive, Monterey Bay aquarium, Canary Row, Fisherman's Wharf, etc. San Francisco is also about 100 miles north.

Lodging - IMPORTANT!!!! You will be responsible for finding your place to stay! There are many small hotels and B & Bs within 5 miles of the golf course (and many are within 1 mile).
