

# FOXBURG HICKORY CHAMPIONSHIP

## 2010 Foxburg Hickory Championship

Foxburg Country Club in Western Pennsylvania is hosting their 2<sup>nd</sup> Hickory Championship this coming August. The dates for the event are Friday, August 13 and Saturday, August 14.

Foxburg Country Club was built in 1887, and is the oldest continuous use golf course in the United States. Joseph Fox built the original five holes in 1887, and he increased the course to nine holes in 1888. Foxburg Country Club is also the home of the American Golf Hall of Fame and Museum, and was added to the National Register of Historic Places in 2007. The course features narrow fairways, with deep rough, and small, fast greens. It is a gem, if you have not had the chance to visit and play, you will want to take advantage of participating in this event.

There are actually two events running concurrently. We have an event for pre-1900 equipment, as well as an event for competitors wishing to utilize later wood shaft equipment. There are reserve divisions for both types of equipment (see the registration form for handicap requirements). The events will consist of 36 holes, 18 each day, which is two trips around the course. Carts are available and included in the entry fee.

The entry fee is \$185, which includes golf for both days and prizes. Three gutty balls engineered by McIntyre-White will be issued to competitors, and must be used in the pre-1900 event (extra balls will be available at the event's cost). Modern balls may be used for the later equipment. The entry fee also includes lunch on the first day and a buffet luncheon Saturday afternoon when play has completed, prior to the awards ceremony.

The event is hosted by the Foxburg Country Club and Tom Johnson, with assistance and guidance from the Society of Hickory Golfers and Region 2 of the Golf Collectors Society.
